Kids Count Inspiration Awards Nomination Form

The six categories from which to choose your nominations are:

ONE. Most inspirational young person.

CRITERIA. An individual young person who has inspired others by their personal dedication, personality, enthusiasm, resilience, flair and commitment to one, or a number of issues affecting the lives of young people.

TWO. Best contribution to youth issues.

CRITERIA. Recognising an individual or organisation whose contribution to youth issues has made a tangible difference and inspired real progress.

THREE. Best contributions to youth organisations.

CRITERIA. The individual or organisation whose contribution and involvement with youth organisations has shown understanding and dedication and has been appreciated by that youth organisation for its positive impact and commitment to its aims and ambitions.

FOUR. Best contribution by a community group.

CRITERIA. Recognising a community group who by example, track record and commitment have signalled that responsibility lies within their own community to protect and foster the well-being and development of young people.

FIVE. Best mentor.

CRITERIA. A truly inspirational individual who has the credibility, experience, patience, tolerance and listening skills to advise, counsel and support young people.

SIX. Best creative contribution.

CRITERIA. The organisation or individual who have simply inspired those around them with their originality and creativity in tackling issues and developing practical and workable solutions.

There will be 2 other special awards which will be made by the Chairman and Director of Kids Count. These will be:

SPECIAL AWARDS

SEVEN. The Chairman's award.

EIGHT. The Director award.

CRITERIA. Both awards to be selected from either existing winners and nominees or other individuals or organisations deemed worthy of special recognition for consistent and truly inspirational dedication to the future development and well-being of young people.

The closing date for nominations is the 30th April 2008. You can really make a difference by simply describing why an individual, a colleague or an organisation is worthy of special recognition by completing the nomination form and e-mailing it back to us. Kids Count would like to thank you for taking the time and trouble to complete and return your nomination or nominations.
